

AQUATIC SUPERVISION POLICY



CHILDREN UNDER 5

(0-4 YEARS OF AGE)


- Supervising adult must be in the water within arm's reach at all times.
- Both supervising adult and child wear a RED WRISTBAND.
- RATIO: 1 adult to 2 children



CHILDREN UNDER 11

(5-10 YEARS OF AGE)

- Must be actively supervised by an adult at all times, without distraction.
- RATIO: 1 adult to 4 children. (If also supervising a child under 5, the adult can supervise a maximum of 3 children aged 5-10).



CHILDREN UNDER 13

(11-12 YEARS OF AGE)

- Must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- An adult is defined as an individual over 17 years of age.
