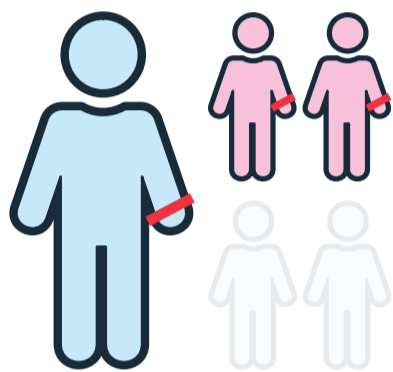
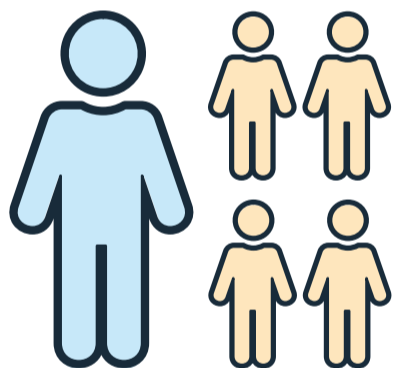


# AQUATIC SUPERVISION POLICY



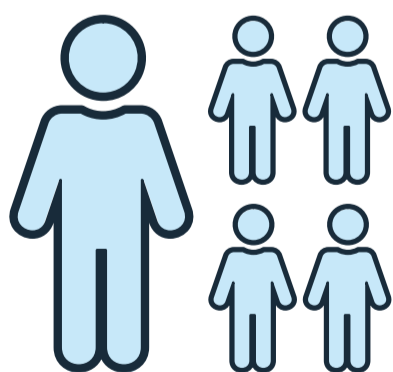
## CHILDREN UNDER 5 (0-4 YEARS OF AGE)

- Supervising adult must be in the water within arm's reach at all times.
- Both supervising adult and child wear a **RED WRISTBAND**.
- **RATIO: 1 adult to 2 children**



## CHILDREN UNDER 11 (5-10 YEARS OF AGE)

- Must be actively supervised by an adult at all times, without distraction.
- **RATIO: 1 adult to 4 children.**  
*(If also supervising a child under 5, the adult can supervise a maximum of 3 children aged 5-10).*



## CHILDREN UNDER 13 (11-12 YEARS OF AGE)

- Must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- An adult is defined as an individual over 17 years of age.

## ARE YOU A WEAK OR NON-SWIMMER?

Accompanied by an adult at all times, regularly checking on child. A parent, guardian or adult is classed as an individual who is over 17 years of age.
